**PROPOSAL TITLE** 

CITIZENS FOR EUROPEAN RURAL AREAS WITH NEW OPPORTUNITIES

**GENERAL OBJECTIVE** 

The project aims to create a **space (community) of cooperation for the social sustainability of the European rural territories**, in order to improve the conditions for citizens' participation in rural areas, promoting social commitment actions that encourage the socioeconomic development in the small municipalities of the European Union and combat aging and depopulation, through solutions and opportunities offered by associationism and cooperativism, as assets of the EU sustainable rural development.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- To analyze the new ruralities, approaches and experiences that challenge the demographic contraction of the European rural territories, and that can provide innovative solutions for a sustainable rural development.
- To identify and promote the opportunities offered by associationism and cooperativism, for the labour occupation of groups of vulnerable people in rural Europe, encouraging social commitment, volunteering and solidarity among European rural citizens.
- To boost the equal opportunities and the creation of new jobs and new opportunities for the rural population (especially for women, young people, people over 55 years old, etc.), appealing to the cooperative principles.
- To raise awareness among European citizens in general and youth in particular, about the importance of the rural areas and its current challenges in terms of depopulation and aging.
- To promote the European citizenship and to improve the conditions for the EU rural population participation, by encouraging citizens' debate on the future of the European rural territories and active participation in the search for solutions that ensure the rural development sustainability.

**TARGET GROUPS:** 

The **target groups** of this project proposal belong to the European rural areas and consist of:

- Local/ regional actors playing an important role in the European rural development policies;
- Federations and associations whose activities are related to the local development and youth;
- Co-operative members and entrepreneurs belonging to the social economy;

## **PARTNERSHIP:**







- Vulnerable groups: young people, women, people older than 55 years, etc.;
- Young people who opted for relatively depopulated territories to undertake a model of life different from that offered by the urban world;
- People who returned to their native rural areas after having emigrated to different cities;
- Rural population in general.

**BUDGET** 

The total budget requested (estimation): 145 000 EUR

### Types of eligible costs:

- Staff costs directly related with the project
- Travelling and accommodation costs of participants during the foreseen actions
- Rooms rental, interpretation and translation services for the foreseen events
- Communication and dissemination costs of the events and
- Coordination costs generated by the participation of several entities
- Research costs and IT tools for preparatory activities

The grant is calculated on the basis of Lump sum financing system fixed per "tranches" (number of participants and number of partner countries) and the same parameters are valid for all participating countries.

Pre-financing: max. 50% of the total budget requested
